The Extra Help program pays for your Part D premium up to a state-specific benchmark amount. **Extra Help will pay the full cost of your Part D premium** when you enroll in a Part D plan with a premium at or below the specified benchmark amount for your state.

Listed below is each state-specific benchmark. If you choose to enroll in a plan that has a monthly premium above your state's benchmark amount or a plan that offers enhanced coverage (coverage that provides additional benefits not required of Part D plans by law), you will have to pay the difference. **Keep in mind that it may be worth paying a higher premium for a plan that covers the drugs you need.**
